The Newcastle Probud Club was formed in 1984, and the purpose of the club is to advance intellectual and cultural interests among adult persons who have retired or are semi-retired from their former occupations.

We hold regular meetings and arrange activities to provide opportunities for fellowship, the development of acquaintance and social interactions. Whilst our club is a “men’s only” club, members’ wives and partners are invited, and encouraged to participate in our luncheons and organised outings.

Regular club meetings are held at the ANZAC rooms at South Newcastle Rugby League Club, at 46 Llewellyn Street Merewether, between 9.30am and 11.30am on the fourth Tuesday of each month. These meetings include an Autobiography or Special Interest talk by a member, Morning Tea, and a Guest Speaker segment.

We have three luncheons throughout the year and members wives or partners are encouraged to come along. It is an excellent way to meet new members, catch up with members you may not get time to talk to at our meetings, and for the wives to get to know each other – all in a friendly and social setting.
